7 Competition Rules and Methods

(1) Competition Rules

All events will be conducted in accordance with the competition rules of WA and local organizing committee and as specified in this document.

(2) Technical Delegate

(3) Competition Rule

① Competition method

a) The qualification rounds will be conducted with three athletes per target butt in a rotation of ABC.

b) The qualification rounds will consist of 6 shots in 4 minutes.

The number of qualifiers will be announced after the number of participants has been confirmed.

c) The final round (RC) will consist of individual match play rounds (by the number of sets won) which are played in five sets (first to 6 points, wins the set).

The final round (CP) will be played as an individual match play.

d) The 122 cm target face will be used in RC.

- e) The 80 cm target face will be used in CP.
- f) The shooting must be performed as follows:
 - A competitor using a wheelchair or a chair must shoot with at least one wheel of the wheelchair or one leg of the chair behind the shooting line.
 - The competitor must not support the bow arm and the bow with the wheelchair or the chair during the shooting.
 - There must be a minimum of 80cm intervals between competitors. In addition, a competitor using a chair must not support his/her body with the back of the chair or armrest.
 - A wheelchair competitor must not put their feet or footrest on the ground.

② Scoring

In the case of a false or incorrect recording of values, the archer or all archers using the same target butt may be disqualified for reasons of failing to check the score.

- Para athlete divisions are determined according to the bow type (Recurve and Compound). There will be no classification for the varying degrees of physical impairment (no wheelchair [W1, W2] or standing/sitting [ST] classes).
- Distance of each division will be the same as that of the General Division.

* Only the Recurve and Compound in the age category of 50+ of men and women will be integrated into the World Archery Masters Championships hosted by WA.

9 Eligibility

- For safety reasons, persons who have archery experience and whose arrows will not miss the target.
- Athletes competing in the Para Athlete Division must be designated a Sport Class Status by their country's para archery federation (Japan Para Archery Federation for Japan).

10 Age Requirement

Minimum age is 30 (born on or before 31 December 1991)

In line with the sport-specific rules, an athlete must compete in their designated age group, with your age determined as at 31 December 2021. For example, if you are 39 during Games time but have turned 40 by 31 December 2021, you would compete in the 40+ age category.

11 Medal Ceremony

The first to third-ranked athletes by event, by gender and by age category will be awarded with medals.

12 Registration Fee

① Competition participants (Basic fee: allowed to participate in 5 disciplines)

a) Overseas participants: 24,000 yen/person

(Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)

b) Domestic participants: 15,000 yen/person

(Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an

additional cost.)

② Persons related to the competition (Basic fee)

a) Overseas participants: 14,000 yen/person

(Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)

b) Domestic participants: 5,000 yen/person

(Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)

*When a helper (a person who supports an athlete with impairment participating in a competition) participates in the competition for providing such support, he/she is required neither to apply for participation in the competition nor to pay a registration participation fee (provided, however, that the helper must apply for participation as a competition official when he/she requires a kit for participating in the competition, a transportation pass and others).

13 How to Apply for Participation

Application is made through the entry system on the official website (Entry System) dedicated to the application for the entry to the competition via PC or smartphone.

14 Notes on Participation

(1) Clothing

- Athletes must wear a sportswear suitable for archery competition.
- Athletes must wear the competition number (bib) to be distributed by the organiser in a visible and identifiable place.

(2) Competition equipment, etc.

① Equipment Regulations

The regulations of WA shall apply.

② Rules on transportation and storage

Athletes must bring the competition equipment in person. (The equipment cannot be shipped in advance to the venue.)

(3) Insurance

The organiser will subscribe to accident insurance for participants, but this insurance is applicable only to “injuries incurred during the competition in the competition venues” of the “competition participants and persons related to the competition”, and does not cover all risks athletes may be exposed to throughout the Games. Participants shall bear the cost of other insurance coverages needed for the period of the Games.

(4) Doping Control

① The doping control in accordance with the [World Anti-Doping Code](#) and [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#) shall apply to this competition.

② Anti-doping activities (doping inspections and anti-doping education activities) shall be conducted in accordance with [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#).

③ Participants are deemed to have agreed to be subject to doping control procedures in accordance with [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#) upon entry to the competition. Participants are advised to check [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#) Rules for more details.

④ This competition aims to promote anti-doping activities as an activity to protect clean sports and clean athletes in order to leave various values of sports to the next generation through sports in cooperation with the Japan Anti-Doping Agency.

(5) Procedure for Bad Weather

If the event cannot be held due to bad weather, the event schedule will be changed (and may be shortened).

16 Others

All participants must complete the accreditation process and check-in at the competition venue before participating (competing or getting involved) in a competition.

(1) Games Accreditation

Accreditation services shall be provided at the Opening Village, each Prefectural Masters Village, Center Village, and the special service desks. The participant must bring a valid photo identification and complete accreditation process personally by one day before the competition (no exceptions allowed). Furthermore, even when participating in team competitions or as a team, each participant must complete the accreditation process.

Accreditation process can be completed at any of the designated service desks; however, operation hours and dates differ depending on the location.
