7 Competition Rules and Methods

(1) Competition Rules

All events will be conducted in accordance with the competition rules of the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI), or as otherwise specified in this document.

(2) Technical Delegate

Takuya Kawata, Vice-Chairman, Tottori Cycling Federation

(3) Competition Rule

- The race will be held in a special course with a distance of 16.2 km.
- The race distance consisting of 5 laps, 4 laps, 3 laps and 2 laps will vary depending on the age category of each competitor.
- Since the road races are held by restricting traffic on public roads, athletes who do not finish within the set time, may be excluded from the races.
- Depending on the number of entries in an age category, categories may be combined in order to conduct a viable competition.

9 Eligibility

(1) Eligibility

Participants must be registered with a UCI member federation as at 2022 as follows:

【Domestic Participants】 Must hold a UCI ID and/or a JCF license with a registration number.

【Overseas Athlete】 Must hold a UCI ID number.

*No temporary license will be issued.

(2) Exclusion of eligibility

Athletes who fall under any of the following cannot participate.

- ① Athletes who have participated in the World Championships, Continental Championships (eg: Asian Championship), Olympics (2020 Tokyo Olympics), Regional Games (eg: Asian Games), and World Cup track races (excluding races only for masters) in 2021 and 2022.
- ② In addition, athletes who have participated in a competition listed on the UCI International Calendar in 2021 or 2022 (any races that earn UCI points such as professional tour races. Not including Gran Fondo or masters competitions which do not award UCI points).
- ③ Athletes who are members of a team registered with UCI in 2021 or 2022.
- ④ Athletes who are suspended or punished by either UCI or the National Federation affiliated with UCI.

** Exclusion rules above do not apply to athletes in para sport divisions except for paragraph 2.④*

(3) Necessary procedures

Declare whether or not you have participated in any road races within 3 years (2019 – 2021).

** As this will be an international event, there will be many athletes racing at the same time on the road. To ensure the safety of all athletes, we recommend that you gain some experience racing in groups and take part in a road race before the Games.*

(4) Para Competition Classes

- ① Japanese nationals with impairments who wish to participate must register with the Japan Cycling Federation before applying for participation.
- ② Overseas nationals with impairments who wish to participate are required to hold the following licenses prior to application and attach copies of licenses in PDF when applying for participation:
 - i) Cycling National License issued by your country's National Federation.
 - ii) Cycling International License required for participating in an international competition (and a designated Sport Class Status)

(5) Para Open classes

- ① Japanese nationals with impairments who wish to participate must register with the Japan Cycling Federation before applying for participation. Additionally, attach a copy of a Disability Certificate or Medical Certificate in PDF when applying for participation:
- ② Overseas nationals with impairments who wish to participate are required to prepare the following 2 documents prior to application and attach copies in PDF when applying for participation:
 - i) Cycling National License issued by your country's National Federation.
 - ii) Disability Certificate or Medical Certificate

10 Age Requirement

Minimum age is 30 (born on or before 31 December 1992)

* Athletes must compete in the age category to which they belong as of 31 December 2022.

(Example: If you are 39 years old during the tournament and you are 40 years old by 31 December 2022, you will compete in the age category 40-44 years old.)

Individuals Men: M1 (30-34), M2 (35-39), M3 (40-44), M4 (45-49), M5 (50-54), M6 (55-59), M7 (60-64), M8 (65-69), M9 (70-74), M10 (75-79), M11 (80-84), M12 (85-89), M13 (90-94), M14 (95+)

Individuals Women: W1 (30-34), W2 (35-39), W3 (40-44), W4 (45-49), W5 (50-54), W6 (55-59), W7 (60-64), W8 (65-69), W9 (70-74), W10 (75-79), W11 (80-84), W12 (85+)

11 Medal Ceremony

- (1) General Divisions : Medals will be awarded to the first to third-ranked athletes by event and by age category.
- (2) Para Cycling Division (Para Competition Classes and Para Open Classes): Medals will be awarded for each para class.

12 Registration fee

- (1) Competition participation fee (including tax and handling fee)

- ① Competition participants (Basic fee: allowed to participate in 5 disciplines)
 - a) Overseas participants: 24,000 yen/person
(Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)

- b) Domestic participants: 15,000 yen/person
(Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)
- ② Persons related to the competition (Basic fee)
 - a) Overseas participants: 14,000 yen/person
(Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic participants: 5,000 yen/person
(Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)

*When a helper (a person who supports an athlete with impairment participating in a competition) participates in the competition for providing such support, he/she is required neither to apply for participation in the competition nor to pay a registration participation fee (provided, however, that the helper must apply for participation as a competition official when he/she requires a kit for participating in the competition, a transportation pass and others).

(2) Additional charges (extra fee)

None

(3) Rental fee for competition equipment, etc.

None (Competition equipment will not be rented.)

* However, if some parts of the equipment (wheel, saddle, handle, etc.) fail to function and become unusable, they may be rented depending on the type of equipment.

13 How to Apply for Participation

Application is made through the entry system on the official website (Entry System) dedicated to the application for the entry to the competition via PC or smartphone.

14 Notes on Participation

(1) Clothing

- There are no particular restrictions except that the UCI World Champion jersey is not allowed to be worn.
- National jerseys and pants may be worn.
- Athletes shall wear jerseys and pants of a team registered with the NF.
- Bibs (race numbers) must be visible on athletes at all times.

(2) Competition equipment, etc.

① Equipment Regulations

- No equipment will be provided by the organiser.
 - Each athlete must bring their own usable equipment which is well serviced and maintained in accordance with the rules.
Equipment with poor maintenance is not allowed to be used.
 - Equipment used must comply with the competition rules.
- ② Rules on transportation and storage
- In principle, each athlete is responsible for their own shipment and safekeeping of equipment.
 - Equipment delivered in advance to the competition venue (start area: Takashiro Elementary School) shall not be accepted.

(3) Insurance

The organiser will subscribe to accident insurance for participants, but this insurance is applicable only to “injuries incurred during the competition in the competition venues” of the “competition participants and persons related to the competition”, and does not cover all risks athletes may be exposed to throughout the Games. Participants shall bear the cost of other insurance coverages needed for the period of the Games.

(4) Doping Control

- ① The doping control in accordance with the [World Anti-Doping Code](#) and [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#) shall apply to this competition.
- ② Anti-doping activities (doping inspections and anti-doping education activities) shall be conducted in accordance with [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#).
- ③ Participants are deemed to have agreed to be subject to doping control procedures in accordance with [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#) upon entry to the competition. Participants are advised to check [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#) Rules for more details.
- ④ This competition aims to promote anti-doping activities as an activity to protect clean sports and clean athletes in order to leave various values of sports to the next generation through sports in cooperation with the Japan Anti-Doping Agency.

(5) Procedure for Bad Weather

The competition may be interrupted, canceled or postponed in bad weather.

16 Others

All participants must complete the accreditation process and check-in at the competition venue before participating (competing or getting involved) in a competition.

(1) Games Accreditation

Accreditation services shall be provided at the Opening Village, each Prefectural Masters Village, Center Village, and the Temporary Accreditation Venue. The participant must bring a valid photo identification and complete accreditation process personally by one day before the competition (no exceptions allowed). Furthermore, even when participating in team competitions or as a team, each participant must complete the accreditation process.

Accreditation process can be completed at any of the designated service desks; however, operation hours and dates differ depending on the location.

(2) Sports Check-in

(3) Inspection of competition equipment

Date and Time: Complete by 30 minutes before the start of each event.

Remarks: Equipment will be checked to ensure that it complies with the regulations.

(4) WMG 2021 Kansai Social Event

- A social event will be held around the competition venue during the cycling races (track and road race).
- Food and beverage stalls and hospitality booths will be set up in the venue during the cycling race (road race).
