### 5 Competition Rules and Methods

#### (1) Competition Rules

- ①The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing rules of sailing (RRS), or as otherwise specified in this document.
- ②No national prescriptions will apply.
- ③If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.



- ④ Decisions of the international jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.
- ⑤ [DP] denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the Protest Committee.
- ⑥ [SP] denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the Race Committee without a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.

(3) Number of racing and Scoring

- ① A maximum of 10 races will be held during the competition period. When four or more races has been completed, the total race score shall be the sum obtained by totaling the scores of these races excluding the worst score.
- ② One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

## 7 Eligibility

Competitors must be members of each member national authority of World Sailing.

## 8 Age Requirement

Minimum age is 30 (born on or before 31 December 1992)

In line with the sport-specific rules, an athlete must compete in their designated age group, with your age determined as at 31 December 2022. For example, if you are 45 during Games time but have turned 46 by 31 December 2022, you would compete in the 46+ age category.

## 9 Medal Ceremony

A medal will be awarded to the first-ranked athlete in each event.

Medals will be awarded to the first to third-ranked athletes by event and by age category.

Provided, however, that when the number of participants is three or less, only the first-ranked athlete will be awarded with the medal.

## 10 Registration Fee

a) Overseas participants: 24,000 yen per person

(Including a transportation pass for mobility in the Kansai area.)

b) Domestic participants: 15,000 yen per person

(Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)

② Persons related to the competition (Basic fee)

a) Overseas participants: 14,000 yen per person

(Including a transportation pass for mobility in the Kansai area.)

b) Domestic participants: 5,000 yen per person

## 12 Notes on Participation

(1) Clothing

All athletes must wear an appropriate personal floating device at all times. Wet suits and dry suits are not considered as appropriate life jackets. If the buoyancy device of a life jacket is inflatable, it must be worn inflated on the water at all times. This has been changed RRS40.

(2) Competition equipment, etc.

① Equipment Regulations

Equipment provided by the organizer may be used. Provided, however, that athletes may participate with own equipment.

(3) Insurance

① The organiser will subscribe to accident insurance for participants, but this insurance is applicable only to “injuries incurred during the competition in the competition venues” of the “competition participants and persons related to the competition”, and does not cover all kinds of risks during the competition. Therefore, all persons taking part in the competition are requested to subscribe to required insurance at own risk and costs.

② Athletes must either pay compensation of 100 million yen or more per incident, or must be subscribed to a valid third party liability insurance with an equivalent amount.

〈Disclaimer of Liability〉

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

(4) Doping Control

① The doping control in accordance with the [World Anti-Doping Code](#) and [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#) shall apply to this competition.

② Anti-doping activities (doping inspections and anti-doping education activities) shall be conducted in accordance with [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#).

③ Participants are deemed to have agreed to be subject to doping control procedures in accordance with [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#) upon entry to the competition. Participants are advised to check [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#) Rules for more details.

(5) Radio Communication

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

(6) Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be posted on the WMG2021 website after the entry closing date.

(7) Advertising

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

(8) Media Rights

All copyrights regarding the event are owned by the organizing authority. Athletes and supporters agree that their boats and their images and names will be exposed to the broadcast, publication, advertising media, etc.

### 14 Others

All participants must complete the accreditation process and check-in at the competition venue before participating (competing or getting involved) in a competition.

(1) Games Accreditation

Accreditation services will be provided at the Opening Village, each Prefectural Masters Village, Center Village, and the Temporary Accreditation Venue. The participant must bring a valid photo identification and complete accreditation process personally by one day before the competition. (No exception will not be allowed.) Furthermore, even when participating in team competitions or as a team, each participant must complete accreditation process.

Accreditation process can be completed at any of designated service desks; however, operation hours and dates differ depending on the location.
